Metadata (or detailed notes, communication from suppliers or similar) are available to identify instances where the conceptual adjustments to the values are required to bridge the source data to the GFSM 2014 framework. 3. Source data coverage (from one or multiple complimentary sources) enables to compile GFS for each sector and subsector consistently with the institutional unit classification, as determined under the GFSM 2014 framework. 4. The data sources for the budgetary subsector of central government enable the precise mapping of economic flows and stocks to the GFSM 2014 taxonomy, with only isolated exceptions.  1. The mapping of the source data to the GFSM 2014 taxonomy is reviewed by the statistical authorities at least on an annual basis, to ensure it continues to meet the needs of GFS statistics and new activities are recorded under the appropriate categories.
